Brunei

Brunei is one of the world's smallest but richest countries. It is on the Island of Borneo, which is divided between Indonesia, Malaysia and Brunei. In this order, these countries control 73%, 26% and 1% of the island. It is the second smallest nation in South East Asia, the smallest being Singapore. Brunei gets its money from oil, which was discovered here in 1929. At that time, the population was around 48,000 but now this has risen to 420,000. This tiny country sells oil worldwide.

Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah is the 29th Sultan of Brunei. He comes from a royal family who are one of the oldest ruling dynasties on earth. The family have ruled Brunei for over 600 years, since 1363. Haji himself was born in 1946 but became sultan in 1967, when his father left the throne after ruling since 1950.

The Sultan has an estimated wealth of over \$20 billion. In 1984, he built the largest palace in the world, costing \$1.4 billion. It has 1,788 rooms, including 257 bathrooms and a dining room which is big enough for 5,000 guests. There is a garage for 110 cars and stables for 200 horses. At that time, the Sultan was the richest man in the world. In 1995, that title went to the founder of *Microsoft*, Bill Gates, who still tops the list today. The Sultan is no longer in the top ten, although he is the second richest royal, after the King of Thailand.
