ROBINSON CRUSOE

Finally, when he was nineteen, Robinson found a ship going to London and set off on his first journey. His dream was about to come true.

But the ship never reached London. Very soon after they set off, there was a terrible storm and the ship sank. Luckily Robinson was safe, but he did not go home. Instead, he continued travelling and after many adventures he arrived in Brazil. There, Robinson built himself a home and started a farm. Years went by, and Robinson set off on a new journey.
