Mount Fuji

Mount Fuji is the highest mountain in Japan. It is 3,776 metres high. It is about 100 kilometres from Tokyo. It is easy to see it from the city on sunny days. Many people know that it is a volcano. They *don't* usually know that it is three different volcanoes on top of each other. It is well-known for its shape. The oldest painting of Mount Fuji is from 1069. In the 1830s, Japanese artist Hokusai Katsushika made 36 different pictures of the mountain.

In 663, the first man climbed to the top of Mount Fuji. He was Japanese but we don't know his name. In 1867, the first woman reached the top. Now, 200,000 people climb Mount Fuji each year. There are four different paths up the mountain. It usually takes about six hours to get to the top and three to get back down.

Many people climb Mount Fuji in the dark to watch the sunrise in the morning. The climbing season is short. It begins on the first day in July and finishes at the end of August. This is because it is very cold and dangerous in other months. You can ski from October to April but you cannot climb. At the top, you can buy tea, send postcards or even have a wedding.
